Guided Thematic Tours

Thematic tours are led by trained Crocker docents and feature works from the permanent collection and special exhibitions on view.

Thematic tours are 50 minutes in length for 1st-12th grade students; 45 minutes for Pre-K and kindergarten students. Tours are offered Tuesday through Friday at 10 AM and 11 AM, and on Wednesdays at 10 AM, 11 AM, NOON and 1 PM. Alternate times are scheduled based on docent availability. Maximum group size per hour is 80 students, and one chaperone is required for every eight students. Tours must be booked four weeks in advance. Tours are \$2 per student for groups in Sacramento County and \$4 per student for groups visiting from outside of Sacramento County. For Pre-K and kindergarten, one chaperone is required for every six students. Teachers and required chaperones are free and additional chaperones are \$4 per person. At the conclusion of all tours, each student receives a GenCorp Foundation Family Pass, which admits up to four people.
