

## Art Access Group Reservation Scholarship Application

The Crocker Art Museum's Art Access program ensures that the Museum is accessible to community groups in the Sacramento region. The Art Access Group Reservation Scholarship Program is for guided or self-guided visits to the Museum and is limited to group visits scheduled June through September and December through February. The fund does not support group reservations made in October, November, March, April, and May.

To qualify for scholarship funds, a community group is required to fill out the Art Access Group Reservation Scholarship Application fully and return it to the Museum at least four weeks before the first preferred tour date option. Within seven days of receipt of the Application, the Crocker's Education & Community Associate will contact the applicant.
