- Special Exhibitions:** The Crocker hosts 5-7 special exhibits each year featuring artwork from an array of time periods, media and cultures. The 2008-09 schedule features exhibitions that include artwork from Warner Bros. cartoons, an examination of Buddha in art, and a look at Maxfield Parrish and the Art of the Print.
- Programs:** The Crocker hosts more than 250 programs and events each year such as Third Thursday Jazz Summer Concerts, Book Club, Meet-the-Artist lectures, Classical Concerts at Sacramento State, Second Saturday for Families and Teacher Workshops. Most programs are free with admission or charge a nominal fee.
- Audience:** In Fiscal Year 06-07, the Crocker welcomed more than 170,000 visitors.
